


1.GET TO KNOW YOUR MUNICIPALITY

The city of Manacor is located on the eastern region of the island of Mallorca. With a coastline of 27 kilometers and a total area of 260.22 square kilometers, Manacor is the second largest municipality in Mallorca. In the interior of the Municipality, you can find the city of Manacor with the villages of Son Macià and Son Negre along the outskirts of the city. To the east of Manacor, you can find the coastal villages of Porto Cristo and s'Illot, along with the residential areas of Cala Murada, Cales de Mallorca, s'Estany d'en Mas, Cala Mendia, Cala Anguila and Cala Morlanda.

Bordering the Municipality of Manacor, to the south is the town of Felanitx. To the west is the village of Vilafranca de Bonany and to the northwest and northeast are the towns of Petra and Sant Llorenç des Cardassar.







2.REGISTER YOURSELF

The municipal register is the official registry of inhabitants of each municipality. Every individual has the right and duty to register, regardless of their administrative situation. The "padrón", or residency certificate, gives you the status of citizen in the municipality and gives you access to basic rights such as health care and schooling.

To register, you must go in person to the offices of the City Council (Manacor, Porto Cristo or s'Illot), from 8.30 a.m. to 2.00 p.m.

The documentation required is as follows:

Valid identification documentation (DNI, NIE, passport). In the case of children under 14 years of age, it is necessary to present the family book or any other documentation proving family relationships.



3.SIGN UP FOR WELCOME SESSIONS HOSTED BY THE TOWN HALL

The City Council of Manacor carries out biweekly information sessions aimed towards residents who have recently arrived to the municipality. The purpose of these sessions are to provide access to basic information regarding the surroundings of the municipality as well as provide knowledge about rights and duties of every resident. In addition, these sessions provide information about resources and services that exist within the municipality. The intent of every session is to alleviate any doubts or concerns any new resident may have upon arrival to the municipality.

4. OBTAIN YOUR HEALTH INSURANCE CARD

The individual health insurance card (TSI) of the Servei de Salut de les Illes Balears (Health Services of the Balearic Islands), also referred to as IB-SALUT, is the document that identifies you as an insured person with the Health Service of the Balearic Islands. This card guarantees access to health services, health centers and the benefits of the public health system. You can request your health card in person at the following health centers provided below, but you must make an appointment beforehand.

5.HAVE YOUR CHILDREN READY FOR SCHOOL

Schooling is **compulsory for all children beginning from the age of six to 16**. However, it is advised that children begin attending school at the age of three in order to develop learning habits from an early age.

JOB SEARCH AND TRAINING

The Balearic Islands Employment Service (SOIB)

If you are 16 years old and have the proper administrative authorization to work or study, you can register with the Servei d'Ocupació de les Illes Balears (The Balearic Islands Employment Service). This service is an autonomous body (written into Law 7/2000, on June 15th) whose main purpose is to plan, manage and coordinate active employment policies. The services functions are to inform, guide and carry out intermediation within the labor market while promoting employment in all its aspects in addition to developing vocational training. Fundamentally, the service is attached to the Ministry of Economic Model, Tourism and Labor.

14.MANAGE YOUR WASTE

Depending on the place of residence, either the door-to-door waste collection system and/or containers must be used.


In the centers of Manacor, Porto Cristo and Son Macià, waste collection is done door-to-door. Waste is collected directly in front of each home. Other types of waste must be separated and correctly discarded according to the schedules and the weekly calendar. Information regarding waste collection is available upon request from the municipal offices.

For the rest of the municipality, waste collection is done amongst five separate containers (paper, glass, cardboard/paper, organic and waste). To use the organic container and benefit from the discounts given towards the waste tax, you must request a card from the municipal offices.
